Snapethorpe concrete repairs:



Replacing the lintels at this local school would have been a significant project. Our remedial solution saved a huge amount of time, disruption and money.

The steel reinforcement bars within the sills and lintels had corroded over time, leading to the expansion and cracking of the surrounding concrete. To restore the structure, we carefully removed the damaged concrete, treated the exposed steel by cleaning and applying an anti-corrosion coating, and then rebuilt the concrete to match the original profile.

Concrete repairs in Preston:

This project involved cutting back eroded concrete to a sound surface and mechanically cleaning an exposed section of rebar.

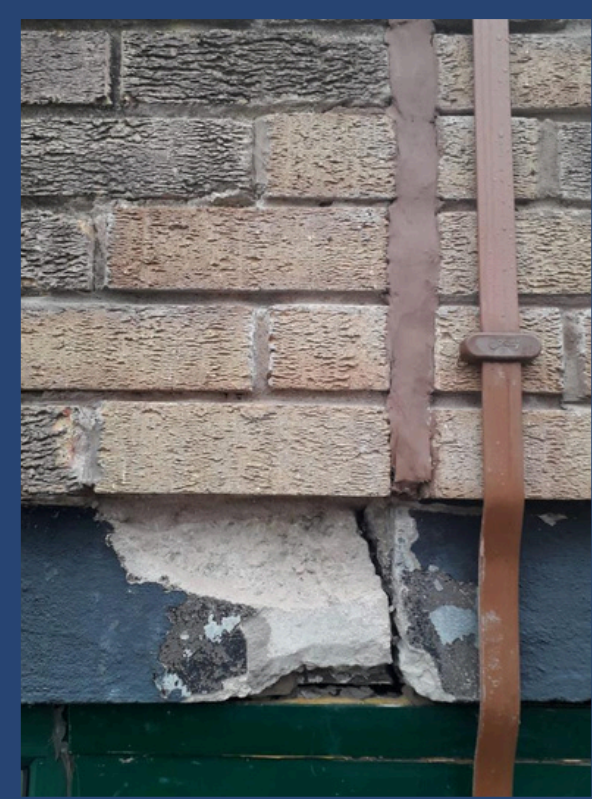
As the concrete was structurally integral – supporting the brickwork above – the removal process had to be carried out with great precision and care

Once repairs were complete, the area was finished with an anti-carbonation coating to help protect it against future environmental damage.

Halifax Stone Repair:

Our team responded quickly to a local organisation after a vehicle damaged a pillar, posing a safety risk.

We removed the twisted dowels, cleaned the mortar bed, then reset the dowels before using Sikadur epoxy resin to bond the pillar components.

The pillar was then carefully reset with a hiab, ensuring safety and stability.

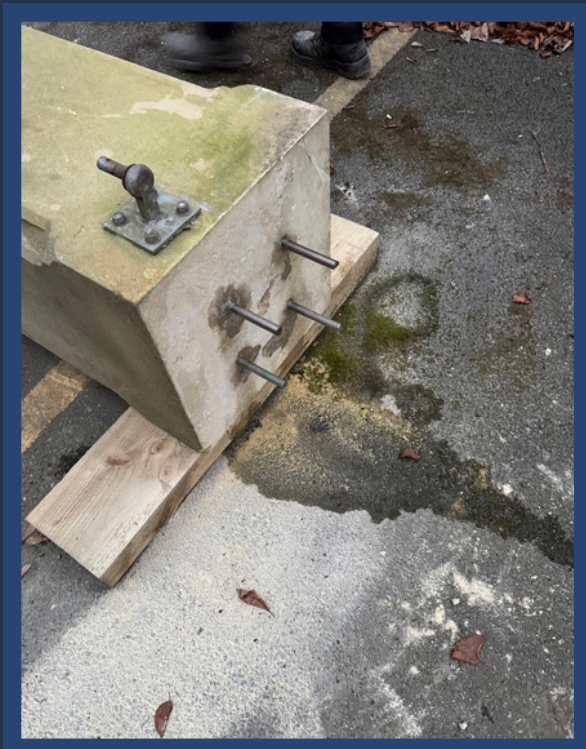
